2022 FAQ

Garbage

- Residential garbage is picked up once a week at curbside or alley.
- Each residence or dwelling unit is allowed four (4) bags or cans per week.
- Proper receptacles are garbage cans with tight fitting covers or plastic garbage bags which are securely tied.
- Garbage must be placed at the alley/curb before 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled day of pickup or placed out the night before.
- Garbage cans shall be removed from the curb/alley the same day as the scheduled pickup.
- **For 30+ gallon cans, garbage must be put in bags before placing in the cans.**
- **For BACKYARD CUSTOMERS- garbage MUST be put in bags before placing in the cans.**

Recycling

Collected Every Other Week

In 1991, Pennsylvania Act 101 was established, mandating that Westmont Borough implement a recycling program. All residents, as well as commercial and institutional establishments are required to recycle. The residential program includes co-mingled recycling of the following:

Aluminum, steel, and bi-metal cans – from beverages and food jars

Plastic – marked with (1) PET and (2) HDPE

Cardboard (cereal and food boxes, gift boxes, etc...)

Corrugated boxes (moving boxes, packing boxes, etc...)

Newspaper

NO GLASS

- Rinse recyclables, remove lids, and leave labels on.
- Do NOT place recyclables in plastic bags
- All boxes must be flattened, cut into NO LARGER than 3' x 3' pieces, tied into bundles and placed beside the recycling container.
- Must be placed at alley/curb before 7:00 AM on scheduled pickup day or night before
- Bins must be removed from curb/alley on same day as scheduled pickup
- Residents may use recycling containers other than those furnished by the borough, but they MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED "RECYCLE"

Your recycling day is your normal garbage day every other week.

Schedule of recycling days is on the following page – recycling weeks are shaded.

Recycling bins are available at the Borough Office

(1-2 bins free per property, additional bins \$10.)

Annual Spring Cleanup

The Annual Trash Pickup will be held on your regular garbage pickup day, as follows:

Monday pickup - May 2, 2022

Tuesday pickup – May 3, 2022

Wednesday pickup – May 4, 2022

- Curb/alley pickup only.
- Refrigerators, Stoves, Air Conditioners, Washers, Dryers should be placed at the CURB.
- Rubbish must be in containers limited to 40 lbs. each.
- Brush, limbs, cuttings, must be bundled in 3 ft. lengths.
- Trash should be out by 7:00 a.m. or the night before.
- Do not put trash out prior to the Saturday before your pickup date.

NO RETURN TRIPS

E-WASTE (including Computers/Monitors/printers) WILL BE COLLECTED

**A dumpster will be placed at 1000 Edgehill Dr. for these items.

The following items will NOT be picked up:

Stones, rocks, broken concrete, automotive parts, tires, wheels, explosives, highly flammable, toxic, radioactive, volatile or illegal materials.

Limbs / Branches Pickup

Limbs/Branches Pickup Schedule:

Week of April 4, 2022

Week of May 2, 2022 (Coincides with Spring Cleanup)

Week of July 11, 2022

Week of August 22, 2022

Week of October 3, 2022

- All Limbs must be out to curb by 7 AM Monday
- No alley pickup
- No yard wastes
- No Root Balls
- Do not bag or box limbs
- Brush, limbs, cuttings, if cut in 3 ft. lengths or smaller MUST BE bundled, they can be longer, but no more than 6" in diameter.

LEAF COLLECTION

MID-OCTOBER TO LAST FRIDAY IN NOVEMBER

Please rake your leaves to the edge of the street - Do not rake leaves onto the street.

Do not place leaves in bags, do not put leaves in alleys.

CHRISTMAS TREES

After the holiday, please place live Christmas trees at the CURB.

The Borough will pick up and dispose.
